



COMMON BASS KNOBS

Volume Knob

1

VOLUME

Adjusts the overall output level of your bass.

2

Tone Knob

TONE

Controls the treble frequencies, making your sound brighter or smoother.

Pickup Blend Knob

3

BLEND

Mixes the signal between the neck and bridge pickups for tonal variety.

4

Bass knob

BASS

Boosts or cuts the low-end frequencies for a deeper or tighter sound.

Mid Knob

5

MID

Enhances or reduces midrange frequencies, affecting presence and "punch".

6

Treble Knob

TREBLE

Adjusts high frequencies, adding clarity or reducing sharpness.

Passive/ Active Switch

7

SWITCH

Toggles between passive mode (no preamp) and active mode (powered EQ controls).

8

Mid-frequency selector

SELECTOR

Lets you choose a specific midrange frequency to boost or cut.

Tone Shaping Switch

9

TONE SHAPE

Alters the overall EQ curve for different tonal characteristics.
